*Whereas* pursuant to Article Three, Section 1, Paragraph D of The Constitution of the Student Congress of Providence College: “The object of Congress shall be to promote, consistent with the Board of Trustees, the administration and the faculty, the best interests of the students of Providence College;”

*Whereas* pursuant to Article Three, Section 2, Paragraph C of The Constitution of the Student Congress of Providence College: “The Congress shall give due consideration to any proposal that any student or group of students may lay before it in writing...”

*Be it hereby enacted* by the 74th Student Congress of Providence College that Business Ethics be approved as a proposed club of Providence College.
