## A RECOMMENDATION

Regarding: Meal Plans for Off-Campus Students

*Whereas* pursuant to Article Three, Section 1, Paragraph A of The Constitution of the Student Congress of Providence College: “The object of the Student Congress shall be to act as the official representative of the student body in order to promote meaningful student participation in the goals of Providence College consistent with the mission statement of Providence College;”

*Whereas* pursuant to Article Three, Section 1, Paragraph D of The Constitution of the Student Congress of Providence College: “The object of Congress shall be to promote, consistent with the Board of Trustees, the administration and the faculty, the best interests of the students of Providence College;”

*Whereas* pursuant to Article Three, Section 2, Paragraph B of The Constitution of the Student Congress of Providence College: “The Congress shall present all justified requests, opinions, complaints, and grievances to the appropriate official, board, or committee;”

*Be it hereby recommended* by the 74th Student Congress of Providence College that the Bursar Office and Office of Residence Life create a new meal plan specifically for off-campus students. Such as a meal plan containing 50 swipes per semester.
